Hygiene Kits

When having your period means you literally can't leave your home, the realities of being a woman hit home hard. Many of our secondary school students don't have the means to buy sanitary materials - even the re-usable material pads. Your gift will provide hygiene kits so that secondary students don't have to miss a school day because of something as simple as not having soap or reusable pads. Period Power!





School Lunch

This gift will give a child lunch in after-school classes in Syria for one week because no child should learn in hunger. When 1 bakery serves a population of over 1/2 million, something as simple as a loaf of bread is out of reach for many in Syria. You can help Syrian children in Aleppo reach their full potential.





Chicken

The gift that keeps on giving! Your gift of a chicken for a family in rural South Sudan will give a mother the chance to add eggs to her children's meals.
